

Recommended Packing List

Dress and pack for the weather. Although it is summertime, Ohio weather can be unpredictable, and your girl will spend time indoors and out. Please consider campus building temperatures fluctuate.

Don't forget your reusable water bottle!

What to Bring

Toiletries:

- Soap for showers
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Lip balm
- Hairbrush or comb
- Sunscreen and non-aerosol waterproof is recommended
- Consider a shower tote

Clothing:

- Walking and closed toe shoes
- One pair of shower shoes (cheap flip-flops recommended)
- Bottoms, one per day plus one extra
- Tops/T-shirts, one per day plus one extra
- One to two sweatshirts, sweaters, or sweatpants (mornings and evenings can be cool walking between buildings)
- Two pairs of appropriate pajamas
- Socks, one per day plus two extra
- Underwear, one per day plus two extra
- Swimsuit
- One beach towel
- Raincoat or poncho

For Specialty Workshops:

- Rock Climbing — Long pants recommended for harness comfort
- Ice Rink — Winter hat, gloves, thick socks, jacket

Optional

- Travel mirror
- 90's outfit or dress for the dance
- Sleeping bag or blanket
- Pillow
- Day bag/Backpack to carry miscellaneous items around campus
- Night light
- One bath towel
- One washcloth
- Sunglasses
- Camera, cheap disposable is recommended
- Book to read during downtime
- Dorm room snacks (no peanut butter)
- Money for vending machine snacks or coffee
- Reusable water bottle
- Dorm room decorations (fairy lights, paper banners, **white** sticky-tak, etc.)

Room decorations may not be affixed to or suspended from ceiling tile, light fixtures, steam pipes, sprinkler heads, or smoke detectors. The removal of mounting putty has the potential to cause the least amount of damage; therefore, its use is permitted with the understanding that damages may result. At the time of final room inspection, charges will be assessed for damages, if any, resulting from the use of removable mounting putty.

What Not to Pack

- Alcoholic beverages
- Candles or incense
- Electric blankets
- Nails, screws, tacks, tape or other adhesives may not be used on walls, ceilings, floors, doors, window trims, or furnishings of rooms
- Glass
- Valuables
- Any weapons (including all knives)
- Pets (this includes during check-in and check-out)
- Personal transportation vehicles
- Tobacco products, including vapes, cigarettes, and lighters.
