Dear Caregiver:

Thank you for your interest in sending your Girl Scout to volunteer day camp. At camp, girls will discover their values and talents through a variety of outdoor activities. Girls will also connect with other girls and adults, learn how to work together as a team, and use that teamwork to take action and make the world a better place. Please complete and return the **Camper Registration, Health History, and Code of Conduct forms** found in this packet, for each camper. (Program Aides and Adults have separate packets)

Adult Volunteers are Needed:

We hope you will see the value in this progressive opportunity and will help keep the history and tradition of day camp alive by volunteering at camp with your Girl Scout. Volunteer-led day camps are run by a dedicated team of specially trained volunteer directors who work year-round to make this enriching opportunity possible. As each camp is staffed completely by adult volunteers to help lead units, activities, and offer support at camp, we encourage you to come spend some time with us to offer this experience to your Girl Scout. We welcome moms, dads, aunts, uncles, grandparents, and other adult friends to volunteer. **Without the support of volunteers, camp is not possible. A background in Girl Scouting is not necessary.**

Space at camp is limited by the number of volunteers, so campers who register with an adult volunteer will be given preference. See the adult volunteer packet for information regarding pixies and boys. Girl Scouts of adult volunteers will receive a reduced rate on their day camp fees. *Training is Mandatory for ALL volunteers.* More information is available in the adult registration packet

Camp Details:

Transportation: Transportation is the responsibility of the caregiver. Drop off and pickup location and times will be detailed in the confirmation packet.

Directions to camp: Stagge-Marr Community Park is located at 6662 Goshen Road. Traveling from State Route 28, turn south on Goshen Road. The park is located on the left side of the road, almost immediately after passing Goshen Middle School. Drop off and pickup is at the Goshen Middle School.

Day Camp Unit: Day Camp is a Beyond the Troop experience. Girls from the same troop are split between units of the same age level.

Food: Campers will need to bring a lunch each day, except for an all camp meal on Friday. The confirmation packet will include suggestions of items that keep well. The campers should bring a full reuseable water bottle and can bring a snack if desired. Each unit will also participate in outdoor cooking once during camp.

Health: A nurse is available at camp. Check with your physician to make sure tetanus and immunizations are up to date. Medications are the responsibility of the caregiver. Campers should give any medications the camper may need to the health supervisor or unit leader in the original container on the first day of camp. Be sure to include written instructions.

Ensure any and all allergies or dietary restrictions are recorded on your Girl Scout's Health History form.

Clothing: Campers will get wet and dirty while having fun, so proper dress for the weather is necessary. Wear closed-toe sturdy shoes, ankle-high (or higher) socks, shirt, and shorts or long pants, with a hat or bandana to help with sun protection. Bring rain gear (a poncho or raincoat, rain boots, but **NO** umbrellas) as camp is not cancelled due to rain. No halter-tops, tube tops, or spaghetti strap tank tops. No sandals, flip flops, or crocs. Regular tank tops that completely cover you ('3-finger straps') are okay.

Insurance: Every registered Girl Scout and registered adult member is automatically covered under the basic plan by Girl Scouts of the USA. This plan is effective from October to the following October. This insurance provides up to a specified maximum for medical expenses incurred as a result of an accident while a member is participating in an approved Girl Scout activity, after the individual's primary insurance pays out.

Buddies: Campers may designate **ONE** buddy (this is optional). Buddies must be in the same level and must choose each other. Buddies who do not choose each other and/or are not in the same level will be disregarded. Remember that buddies are not a requirement! Many campers come to camp without a buddy and make new friends quickly.

Caregivers: If you feel this camp is unsafe or a hazard to children you, should contact Clermont County Children's Services Department at 513.732.7173 or Clermont County Combined Health District at 513.732.7499.

Late registrations may be accepted after the April 30, 2024 deadline at our discretion with space permitting, an adult volunteer registration, and accompanied by the \$25 late fee.

*Girl Scout Cadettes going into grades 6-8 work towards becoming Program Aides. The first step is earning the Leadership in Action Award (LiA) while at camp. This unit is for girls going into grade 6. They enjoy the fun of camp and work with Brownie Girl Scouts. They will spend the night Wednesday of camp. Once a Cadette GS has earned the LiA, the next step is to take a council training and complete six sessions working with younger girls. We will hold a PAT training on Saturday, May 18, 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m at Trinity UMC on Wolfpen Pleasant Hill Rd. GSWO also has a training available on Saturday, May 4. Your PAT will need to attend one of these training sessions. The PAT unit will spend the night at camp Thursday.

All school age girls and adults participating in camp must be registered members of Girl Scouts. If registration is necessary, please go to gsw.org/join

There is an online option for registering for day camp at Rallyhood, which takes credit cards. If paying by check, make checks payable to **“Girl Scouts of Western Ohio Volunteer Day Camp 5B”**. Complete the registration, additional information and release forms and return with payment to:

Do not send registrations to the Girl Scout Center. All registration received at the Girl Scout Center will be forwarded to the appropriate day camp on a weekly basis and may cause your child to be closed out of camp.

Financial Assistance: Financial assistance may be available for girls who want to attend but are unable to do so because of limited family income. Applicants must pay at least 50 percent of the day camp fee. Please include payment for the total amount your family can pay with the registration form.

Confirmation Email: If you have not received a camp confirmation email by **May 12, 2024**, please contact Day Camp staff by email at DayCamp5Bisfun@gmail.com. Please put ‘Day Camp 2024’ in the subject line.

Refund Policy: Money may be refunded for the following reasons only:

1. Moving out of town.
2. Illness or exposure to a communicable disease.
3. Required attendance at summer school.
4. Camp capacity is reached, and no other camp is attended; refund will be sent within four weeks of registration date.

Authorization for Treatment: In the event reasonable attempts to contact me at the provided phone numbers have been unsuccessful, I hereby give my consent to the administration of emergency medical treatment by any licensed physician or dentist and to transfer the child to any reasonably accessible hospital facility. This authorization does not cover major surgery unless the medical opinions of two other licensed physicians or dentists, concurring in the necessity for such surgery, are obtained prior to the performance of such surgery.

CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

I, _____ (Girl Scouts name), understand that my attitude and behavior are important to my success and the success of others in at camp I will follow the Girl Scout Promise and Law and agree to the following:

1. I will follow the established Unit Agreement and will abide by all those rules.
2. I will be sensitive to the needs of my fellow Girl Scouts by performing my assigned duties including unit and all-camp kapers and participate in all camp activities.
