3. Follow the easy directions to reserve a facility or site.

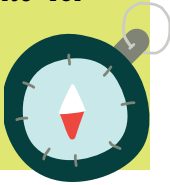
Members are encouraged to reserve properties online. It's faster and easier for you, less expensive for the council, and it's green! However, you do have the option to submit a paper form.

Facility Type & Description	Availability
Meeting Room Office areas designed for group meetings.	Year-Round
Lodge Building including some amenities (varies with properties).	3 to 4 Seasons
Platform Tents Wooden platform with canvas tent and rain fly (usually sleeps 4 with cots and mattresses provided).	Mid-April through Mid-October
Adirondacks Wooden bunkhouses that contain 2 bunk beds (4 beds) and mattresses.	April-October
Cabins Building facility that provides some, but not all, amenities. Some cabins may not have electricity, water, or bathrooms in building but have them nearby.	Year-Round
Tree Houses Three- or four-sided structures elevated above ground.	Mid-April through Mid-October
Covered Wagons Sleeping structures designed to resemble pioneer wagons (usually sleeps 5 on cots with mattresses).	Mid-April through Mid-October
