

Sit-upons- Bucket

Supplies needed:

- 5 gallon bucket with lid
- 11" diameter wood circle (at least 1/2 inch thick). Can cut your own.
- A vinyl or plastic table cloth, 16' square cut out.
- Stuffing
- A staple gun and staples
- 3/4 inch screws
- Electric screw driver
- Duct tape

Instructions

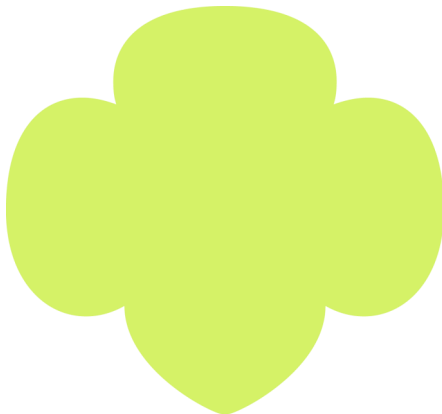
- Lay table cloth piece pattern side down.
- Place a generous amount of stuffing in the middle of table cloth piece.
- Place wood circle on top.
- Wrap cloth tightly around the wood piece, using the staple gun to secure it to the board.
- Place seat cushion on top of the bucket lid.
- Turn bucket lid over and using the screws screw through the bucket lid into the wooden piece, securing cushion to bucket lid.
- Use duct tape to decorate the rest of your bucket.
- Take your sit-upon to your next camp out storing your necessities inside.
- Enjoy your seat around the campfire.



Sit-upons- Reusable Bag

Instructions:

- Cut the sewed seams/side panels off the reusable shopping bag.
- Lay the reusable bag out flat (waterproof/plastic side down) and place the newspaper on one half of the laid out bag.
- Fold the other side of the bag over the newspaper so that the newspaper is sandwiched between the two sides of the reusable shopping bag.
- Using the duct tape, tape the seams of the bag that are open so that the newspaper is sealed into the bag. When you get to the seam with the bag handles, you will need to cut off the handles before you can tape that side closed.
- Once you have finished taping the three open edges, re-tape the bag handles back on to allow for easy carrying.
- All taped up? Now it's time to test out your sit-upon.



Supplies needed:

- 1 Reusable Shopping bag
- 1 Stack of Newspapers
- 10-15 feet of Duct Tape (recommend fun colors)
- Scissors
